24/25 - DRESS CODE/UNIFORM POLICY FOR FCPMS

LANYARDS/IDs: Student IDs MUST be worn at ALL times on campus. They must be worn on the correct lanyards for each grade level, around their necks. (6th grade - yellow, 7th grade - red, & 8th grade - black) IDs must have a visible student photograph, their full name, student number, and barcode. If IDs are missing any of those required portions, the student will be responsible for purchasing a new ID in the office.

"TOPS/SHIRTS"

Allowed:

Colors & Styles:

- ★ Must be any one solid color
- ★ Must have a collar, long or short sleeve, and/or can be a turtleneck
- ★ Must be long enough to cover your midsection when arms are raised











Not Allowed:

Color & Styles:

★ Decorations or writing on them (unless specifically approved by FCPMS)







"BOTTOMS"

Allowed:

Colors & Styles:

- ★ Must be one, solid color black (can be black jeans), navy blue, tan/khaki
- ★ Blue jeans with NO rips
- ★ Can wear pants, shorts, capri pants, cargo pants, jumpers, skirts, skorts
- * All underclothes MUST be solid black or white tights, leggings, compression shorts/pants







Not Allowed:

- ★ Other colors, leggings (as pants), sweats, athletic joggers, baggy or saggy bottoms, or any decorations on them
- ★ Shorts or shirts cannot be shorter than 3 inches above the knee
- ★ Must be of reasonable size and hemmed
- ★ Must be in good condition NO rips or tears









"OUTERWEAR/JACKETS"

Allowed Colors & Styles (indoors and outdoors):

- ★ Jackets, sweaters, hoodies, sweatshirts, vests, etc. to be worn *inside* or outside need to be school-appropriate.
- ★ Outerwear of *any* color may be worn but must be school-appropriate.
- ★ MUST be worn in the fashion it was intended correct arm/chest direction

Not Allowed:

- ★ Outerwear worn inside out, backwards, etc.
- ★ No inappropriate/offensive logos or decoration related to drugs, alcohol, weapons, or anything else that would cause a disruption to the learning environment











"OTHER DRESS CODE INFORMATION"

Allowed:

Shoes/Socks/Tights:

- ★ Shoes MUST have a strap on the back
- ★ Crocs are okay and DO NOT need to be in Sport Mode
- ★ Shoes must be safe and appropriate for school
- ★ Tights, if worn under shorts or skirts, must be solid be solid black or white

Headwear/Hats:

- ★ One solid color beanie/sock hat can be worn outside only (school appropriate)
- ★ Hoods on outerwear can be worn outside

Not Allowed:

- ★ NO flip flops, slides, slippers, or heels higher than 2 inches
- ★ Shoes, socks, and/or tights may not have inappropriate/offensive images or decorations on them
- ★ NO hats/hoods worn inside
- ★ NO visible tattoos
- ★ NO baseball caps or other styles of hats allowed on campus (unless approved by FCPMS administration)
- ★ NO bandanas

"SPIRIT DAYS & DRESS DOWN DAYS"	
Spirit Days:	
★ Every Friday - students may wear a school spirit shirt, Tempe Union High School, or a college shirt with blue jeans, or normal uniform bottoms	
Dress Down Days:	
Students may get dress down days throughout the school year. Please follow the rules below.	
 ★ NO tank tops, racerback tops, tube tops, or midriff- baring tops - all tops MUST have sleeves ★ Pajamas are NOT allowed ★ Undergarments must not show ★ Length of bottoms cannot be shorter than 3 inches above the knee ★ Makeup, shoes, headwear standards remain the same as with the regular dress code ★ Clothing to be worn in good condition - no excessive rips or tears ★ As always, IDs MUST be worn at all times
